### DISCUSSION

- A. This donation will fund the purchase of one mobile workstation and six rifle scopes for the Robbery-Homicide Division (RHD). The mobile workstation will be used by RHD's Crime Analysis Detail to conduct video analysis, call detail records analysis, link analysis, and cell phone forensics after-hours and off-site at crime scenes and command posts. The rifle scopes will be used by the Special Investigation Section (SIS) Designated Marksman Rifle (DMR) cadre to facilitate tactical situations which require the need to identify imminent deadly threats at great distances. The scopes will replace current equipment nearing the end of their service life and provide increased magnification, greater standoff distances, and more potential for de-escalation.
- B. This donation will fund the purchase of equipment for the Mobile 9 Command Post Vehicle, a Crime Scene Response Vehicle, and the SIS. The Mobile 9 is utilized by the RHD as a mobile command post during critical and on-going field operations and much of the equipment has become worn, old, or non-functioning. This grant will provide replacement whiteboards, portable drives, computer speakers, intercom, and scanner for the Mobile 9.

The RHD is in the process of obtaining a Crime Scene Response Vehicle. This grant will furnish RHD's vehicle with this necessary equipment, such as canopies, work flood lights, blower fans, power inverters, and heavy-duty tools.

The SIS is involved in the surveillance and apprehension of armed recidivist criminals. As such, the likelihood of a critical incident where emergency medical care is needed is ever present. The SIS has five emergency medical technicians (EMTs) trained to treat traumatic injuries. This grant will provide three replacement oxygen regulators to ensure that treatment can be properly administered, if needed.

Due to the nature of its mission, the SIS requires specialized equipment. The SIS routinely deploys under low light conditions, and all deadly force options must be outfitted with Weapon Mounted Lights (WML). This grant will provide the SIS with 25 weapon lights and 25 remote weapon light switches for seat guns and ensure that SIS detectives are not at a disadvantage in the event they are ambushed in their vehicle at night while on surveillance. This grant will also provide for the SIS DMR cadre 40 rifle magazines for special ammunition utilized during tactical deployment and six sets of laser range finders and precision extended cantilever mounts for facilitating tactical situations which require the need to identify imminent deadly threats at great distances.

### **NAME OF GRANT: DELL MOBILE WORKSTATION AND PERFORMANCE DOCK, AND VORTEX RAZOR GEN III RIFLE SCOPES**

It is requested that Robbery-Homicide Division (RHD) be approved for funds to purchase a Dell Mobile Workstation for the Crime Analysis Detail (CAD), and six Vortex Razor Gen III Optics for Special Investigation Section (SIS). Approval of this grant benefits the Department as follows:

#### **Dell Mobile Workstation and Performance Dock – Quantity 1**

The Dell Mobile Workstation is a thin, lightweight, high-powered business laptop. Robbery-Homicide Division is responsible for investigating high-priority and time-sensitive cases, including, but not limited to: bank robberies, extortions, kidnappings, human trafficking, serial killers, arson murders, criminal aspects of Officer Involved Shootings (OIS) investigations, murder-for-hire, assaults and threats to Department sworn and civilian personnel, and other cases as assigned by the Chief of Police.

Due to the nature of these cases, investigators often collect a large amount of digital data including video surveillance, call detail records, and cell phone forensics which often includes information regarding large criminal organizations or a complex sequence of events. The requested mobile workstation would be used for software geared toward video analysis, call detail records analysis, link analysis, and cell phone forensics. These investigations often require after-hours and off-site response. A mobile workstation would allow CAD analysts to respond to crime scenes and command posts to provide investigators with information in a timely manner. The performance dock will allow analysts to connect devices to the workstation for analysis.

#### **Vortex Razor Gen III 1-10X24 EBR-9MOA – Quantity 6**

The Vortex Razor is low variable power optic with 1 to 10 magnification used to identify an imminent deadly threat at great distances. The SIS Designated Marksman Rifle (DMR) cadre currently uses US Optics 1x6 power rifle scopes that are nearing the end of their service life. The Vortex scope offers first focal plane sighting (clearer glass) and extended range by a power of 4. The increased magnification will allow for greater stand-off distances. Greater distances will allow for more potential de-escalation under the “decision making time is increased by greater distance and cover” principal. Moreover, by allowing for greater standoff distance, less lethal munitions could be utilized including increased verbalization and hopefully eliminate the need for deadly force altogether.

Robbery-Homicide Division (RHD) is requesting <sup>1,306.87</sup> ~~1197.37~~ (includes tax) for equipment for the Mobile 9 Command Post for Investigations at Scenes of Major Incidents. The request is to replace/ update old non-functioning equipment such as dry erase whiteboards, portable drives, computer speakers, intercom, and a scanner. These items will increase the efficiency of the Mobile 9 Command Post Vehicle. *js*

Robbery-Homicide Division is requesting \$3269.23 (includes tax) for supplies to equip a Crime Scene Response Vehicle. Robbery-Homicide Division is in the process of obtaining a vehicle to use as a Crime Scene Response Vehicle and the equipment, such as canopies, work flood lights, blower fans, power inverters, and heavy-duty tools such as bolt cutters, wrecking bars, ladders, and power tools, etc. is necessary to access areas of crime scenes, particularly in vacant or abandoned buildings, or scenes of an arson related homicide, and to facilitate the timely processing of unusual and complex crime scenes.

RHD is requesting \$11997.18 (includes tax and shipping) for 3 Dyna Med oxygen regulators to replace old regulators used by Special Investigation Section (SIS) emergency medical technicians for critical incidents when emergency medical care is needed, 25 each Surefire X300 Ultra-A weapon lights and Surefire DG-11 remote weapon light switches for G17 to outfit SIS detective's seat guns with weapon mounted lights for low light tactical situations, 40 Magpul Industries rifle magazines for SIS's Designated Marksman Rifle (DMR) cadre for special ammunition utilized during tactical deployment, and six each Vortex laser range finders and Vortex precision extended cantilever mounts for the SIS DMR cadre to facilitate tactical situations which require the need to identify imminent deadly threats at great distances.

**NAME OF GRANT: MOBILE 9 COMMAND POST EQUIPMENT, CRIME SCENE RESPONSE VEHICLE EQUIPMENT, DYNA MED OXYGEN REGULATORS, SUREFIRE WEAPONS LIGHT AND REMOTE SWITCHES, MAGPUL INDUSTRIES RIFLE MAGAZINES, VORTEX LASER RANGE FINDER, AND VORTEX PRECISION EXTENDED CANTILEVER MOUNT**

It is requested that Robbery-Homicide Division (RHD) be approved for funds to purchase Mobile 9 Command Post equipment, Crime Scene Response Vehicle equipment, three Dyna Med oxygen regulators, 25 each Surefire weapons light and remote switches, 40 Magpul Industries rifle magazines, six Vortex laser range finders, and six Vortex precision extended cantilever mounts. Approval of this grant benefits the Department as follows:

### **Mobile 9 Command Post Equipment – Various Items**

Mobile 9, one of the Department's Command Post Vehicles, is utilized by RHD as a mobile command post during critical and/or on-going field operations. Mobile 9 was activated in 2008 and last updated in 2015. Much of the equipment on Mobile 9 has become worn from use or is outdated and required minor updating by replacement of two Realspace magnetic 24'x36" dry-erase white boards, two SanDisk Extreme portable external 2TB Solid State Drives (SSD), a Logitech BRIO 4K Ultra HD webcam, 4-pair Amazon Basic USB-powered computer speakers, and UHPPOTE non-visual one to one intercom, and the addition of a Epson WorkForce ES200, portable duplex scanner with auto-document feeder. These items will increase the efficiency of the Mobile 9 Command Post Vehicle.

### **Crime Scene Response Vehicle Equipment – Various Items**

A Crime Scene Response Vehicle is equipped with various items that can facilitate the investigation at crime scenes with unusual characteristics, such as being outdoors in inclement weather, low or no lighting, and in vacant/ and or abandoned buildings, etc. When faced with these and similar complex crime scenes, RHD detectives are often hindered by a lack of resources such as canopies, work flood lights, blower fans, power inverters, and heavy-duty tools such as bolt cutters, wrecking bars, ladders, and power tools, etc. necessary to access areas of crime scenes, particularly in vacant or abandoned buildings, or scenes of an arson related homicide. The lack of resources often causes delays in the processing of crime scenes and the collection of evidence. Robbery-Homicide Division is in the process of obtaining a vehicle to use as a Crime Scene Response Vehicle and the equipment is necessary to facilitate the timely processing of unusual and complex crime scenes.

**DYNA Med Oxygen Regulator 50PSI Model #L24030-GA – Quantity 3**

Oxygen regulators and oxygen tanks are medical devices used to deliver and regulate supplemental oxygen to a person that requires oxygen therapy. The Special Investigation Section (SIS) is routinely involved in the surveillance and apprehension of armed recidivist criminals. Due to the nature of their mission, the likelihood of a critical incident where emergency medical care is needed is ever present. Special Investigation Section has trained and deployed five emergency medical technicians (EMTs). Each EMT is equipped with a medical bag used to treat traumatic injuries. Additionally, each EMT deploys an oxygen cylinder to provide emergency O2. Each cylinder needs an O2 regulator to properly administer that treatment. Currently, three cylinders need replacement regulators.

**Surefire X300U-A weapon lights and Surefire DG-11 remote switches for G17 – Quantity 25 each**

The Surefire X300U-A is a weapon light that attaches to a detective's pistol and allows for threat identification under low light conditions. The DG-11 remote pressure switch is an attachment that secures to the back of the weapon light. Because SIS routinely deploys under low light conditions, it is necessary that all of their deadly force options including shoulder weapons, personal defense weapons, vest-mounted handguns and seat guns be outfitted with Weapon Mounted Lights (WML).

Currently SIS does not have the funding to issue detectives a WML for their seat gun. This puts the detective at a disadvantage in the event they are ambushed in their vehicle at night while on surveillance. The DG-11 remote switch is used in concert with the Surefire light and allows the detective to use their middle finger to activate the light. This action allows illumination if the detective's support hand is injured or if their support hand is conducting another task (i.e. rescuing a hostage or opening a door).

**Magpul Industries, Rem/5.56 NATO, 20 round in Black – Quantity 40**

Black Magpul 20 round polymer rifle magazines are used by the SIS Designated Marksman Rifle (DMR) cadre for two specific reasons. First, the material (polymer versus aluminum) denotes the special ammunition used in the magazine (70 grain Black Hills TSX) versus the special ammunition used in the USGI aluminum SIS Kit Kat M4's SBRs. The ammunition is not interchangeable and would cause malfunctions if swapped. By using black polymer magazines in the DMR rifles, it eliminates the possibility of a mistake under duress. Additionally, the 20 round magazines are used because the size (versus 30 round USGI magazines) allows the detectives to get into the tight cover positions demanded when working in and around vehicles.

**Vortex Laser Range Finder LRF101 – Impact 1000 yard – Quantity 6**

A laser range finder is a device used to accurately identify the distance between a covering detective and the potential deadly threat. The laser range finder is a critical piece of kit for DMR cadre members and spotters because it allows them to accurately identify the distance of a deadly threat and make necessary sight dope adjustments (data of how the rifle and ammo performs at given ranges) and hold-overs in the scope reticle to quickly stop an imminent deadly threat and minimize the possibility of hitting an unintended target.

**Vortex Precision Extended Cantilever Mount 34mm – Quantity 6**

The Vortex Precision Extended Cantilever Mount is a device which mounts the Vortex Razor Optic to a rifle. The SIS DMR cadre is replacing the current US Optics 1x6 power rifle scopes with the Vortex Razor Gen III 1-10X24 EBR-9MOA. The mount is merely the device used to attach the scope to the rifle and is a mandatory piece of kit.
