FACT SHEET 2020 FOURTH QUARTER AND YEAR END HATE CRIME ANALYSIS February 4, 2021

During the 4th Quarter of 2020, there were 93 Hate Crimes and 41 Hate Incidents compared to 79 Hate Crimes and 51 Hate Incidents for the 4th Quarter of 2019. This represents a hate crime increase of 17.7% and a hate incident decrease of 19.6%.

The following is an analysis of Hate Crimes and Incidents for the Year of 2020. The end of year totals for Hate Crimes Citywide were 355 in 2020 compared to 339 in 2019. This represents an increase of 4.7%. The end of year totals for Hate Incidents Citywide were 199 in 2020 compared to 172 in 2019. This represents an increase of 15.7% from the prior year.

*NOTE: Due to some crimes having multiple biases against protected characteristics, the total number of hate crimes per biases is greater than the total number of hate crimes YTD.

NOTABLE TRENDS/TOPICS FOR 2020:

- On December 31, 2019, China reported a cluster of cases of pneumonia in Wuhan, Hubei Province. A novel coronavirus was eventually identified. During the beginning of the new year of 2020, media accounts and anecdotal stories on social media addressed a trend of anti-Asian hate crimes and hate incidents due to fear of the coronavirus.
- On May 26, 2020, George Floyd was killed in Minneapolis, MN while in police custody. This resulted in nationwide protests regarding the treatment of Black citizens in the United States.

RACE / ETHNICITY:

In the City of Los Angeles, there has been an increase in anti-race biased crimes. There is no evidence that this increase is related to hate/extremist groups or activity. None of the LAPD investigations showed any relation to local or national hate groups. The most common crimes for race biased crimes were criminal threats.

- During 2020, there were 15 anti-Asian hate crimes compared to seven during 2019. This represents an **increase** of 114%.
 - o 35% of anti-Asian suspects were White.
 - o 35% of anti-Asian suspects were Hispanic.

o 29% of anti- Asian suspects were Black.

NOTE: There were nine anti-Asian hate incidents compared to seven during 2019. This represents an **increase** of 28.6%.

- There were 77 anti-Black hate crimes during 2020 compared to 73 last year. This represents an increase of 5.5%.
 - o 60% of anti-Black suspects were Hispanic.
 - o 35% of anti-Black suspects were White.
- There were 57 anti-Hispanic hate crimes during 2020 compared to 42 during the same period last year. This represents an **increase** of 35.7%.
 - o 76% of anti-Hispanic suspects were Black.
 - o 17% of anti-Hispanic suspects were White.

NOTE: During 2020, there were several protests in the Los Angeles area regarding a conflict between Turkey and Azerbaijan. The Armenian and Azeri communities clashed multiple times in the City of Los Angeles over these issues.

RELIGION:

The largest affected community for hate crimes in the religion category during 2020 was the Jewish community. There were 38 religious-biased crimes committed against the Jewish community. The most common religious-biased crimes are vandalisms and annoying communications.

- There were 48 anti-Semitic hate crimes during 2020 compared to 80 during last year. This represents a **decrease** of 40%.
 - o 47% of anti-Jewish suspects were White.
 - o 27% of anti-Jewish suspects were Black.
 - o 20% of anti-Jewish suspects were Hispanic.

NOTE: LAPD changed the way it recorded the bias motivation for swastika vandalism cases. In 2020, the LAPD recorded all swastika vandalisms without any additional context as anti-Jewish. Prior to the year 2020, these cases were classified as anti-multiple races/religions.

SEXUAL ORIENTATION:

The largest affected community for hate crime in the sexual orientation category during 2020 was the gay male community. The most prevalent crimes were Aggravated/Simple Assault, vandalism and criminal threats. The victims of these crimes were often confronted regarding their sexual orientation resulting in a verbal or physical altercation.

- There were 70 anti-gay (Male) hate crimes during 2020 compared to 54 during last year. This represents an **increase** of 29.6%.
 - o 38% of anti-gay (Male) suspects were Black.
 - o 32% of anti-gay (Male) suspects were Hispanic.
 - o 23% of anti-gay (Male) suspects were White.

GENDER BIAS:

The primary community affected by hate crimes in the gender-bias category was the transgender community. During the year 2020, there were 29 crimes against the transgender community. The victims of these crimes were often confronted regarding their gender identity, resulting in a verbal or physical altercation. The most common gender-biased crimes were assaults and criminal threats.

- There were 29 anti-transgender hate crimes during 2020 compared to 23 last year. This represents an **increase** of 26.1%.
 - o 41% of anti-transgender suspects were Black.
 - o 41% of anti-transgender suspects were Hispanic.

CRIMES:

- There were 93 aggravated assaults during 2020 compared to 54 during last year. This represents an **increase** of 72.2%.
- There were 102 simple assaults during 2020 compared to 86 during last year. This represents an **increase** of 18.6%.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In 2020, the LAPD entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigations to create the Los Angeles Hate Crimes Task Force.
- In 2020, the LAPD created a new Hate Crimes Policy and updated the Hate Crimes Brochure and Hate Crime Supplemental Reports.
