DISCUSSION

This donation will provide 18 medical bags for the Metropolitan Division's Crime Impact Team (CIT). The CIT conducts surveillance of individuals involved in violent felonious crimes and undercover controlled buys. The CIT conducts cases in four different counties, often very distant from a Level 1 Trauma Center. Approval of this grant will allow medical aid to be administered in situations where officers sustain serious injury and afford the team time to transport injured officers to a proper medical facility.






