**NARRATIVE**

**SUMMARY:**

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, Officer Acevedo, Serial No. 38973, currently assigned to the Los Angeles Police Department, Commission Investigation Division, Enforcement Section, was assigned this application for further investigation.

The business is owned by AALACA, Inc, DBA On & Off, located at 3625 W 6<sup>th</sup> St #101 Los Angeles, CA 90027, in Olympic Area; and the business applied for a Café Entertainment and Shows Police Commission permit.

**PERMIT HISTORY:**

On & Off has a California Liquor License type - 47 (619397). This type of license authorizes the sale of beer, wine and distilled spirits for consumption on the premise. Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption off the license premises. Must operate and maintain the premises as a bona fide eating place.

Additionally, the location is properly zoned for the proposed activities. A query on the ZIMAS database, revealed there is a Conditional Use Permit (CUP).

**INVESTIGATION:**

On November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Permit Processing Unit received an application for a Café Entertainment/Show Permit.

On December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021, a notice of application for permit was sent to the Olympic Area Vice, Department ABC coordinator (Sgt Garcia), Councilman Mike Feuer's office, and the Olympic neighborhood council. No opposition was received.

The business is owned solely by Dae Jun Gwag (owns 100%). On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, Acevedo reviewed the applicant's background and Mr. Gwag's criminal history revealed a valid California Driver License, no arrests or convictions in the time prescribed under 103.31 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, and no wants/warrants.

On April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Officer Acevedo, accompanied by Officer Padilla, Serial No. 36865, conducted the initial inspection at approximately 1:00 p.m., during closed hours of operation. The karaoke business is located at 3625 W 6<sup>th</sup> St., which sits on the North side of 6<sup>th</sup> St., between Ardmore Ave. and Normandie Ave. On & Off is in a shopping center which shares a lot with a health center and a tax preparation office, and both the parking lot and main entrance is located on the North side of the building.

Mr. Gwag and his consultant, Mr. Steve Kim, assisted with the walk-thru inspection and several photos were taken. Upon entry of the business is the hostess desk, and as you continue down the hallway, the kitchen is located to the left and a total of eleven Karaoke

rooms. The rooms are well lit and there was no was no obstruction to our view.

On April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at approximately 10:00 p.m., Officer Acevedo, accompanied by Detective Moisa, conducted an unannounced follow-up night inspection at On & Off and the business was in full operation. Currently, the business hours are from 8:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. Upon arrival, a security guard was at the front entrance checking ID's with an age verification scanner. Once we entered the business, we proceeded to the hostess desk and were met by Mr. Gwag. We did a walk -through and observed numerous patrons socializing inside the karaoke rooms. As we proceeded, we were greeted by an employee whom was serving food to the patrons. At the time of the inspection, only two karaoke rooms were occupied. We entered one room and observed patrons eating; and entered the second occupied room and observed patrons singing karaoke. After inspecting the two rooms, we did one last walk-thru of the entire business to ensure everything was in compliance. The inspection determined adherence to all protocols and criteria, so the inspection was concluded.

Subsequent to the inspection and due to no opposition received from Olympic Area, Department of ABC coordinator, Councilman Mike Feuer's office, or the Olympic neighborhood council, and no zoning issues; it is CID's recommendation that the application for a Café Entertainment and Shows Police Commission permit be granted to On & Off Karaoke.

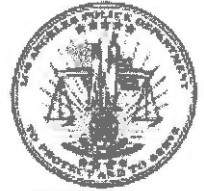
