### DISCUSSION

The donation is for Measure Ground Control computer flight tracking software. The software will be used by the Los Angeles Police Department's (Department) small Unmanned Aerial System (sUAS) pilot program administered by Metropolitan Division, Special Weapons and Tactics, and managed through Air Support Division. The software, once installed in sUAS operating tablets (IPAD), will provide detailed flight reports for all training and deployment operations. There are no maintenance or administrative costs associated with this donation. Director of Systems, Karen Bottancino, Commanding Officer, Information Technology Division, has approved the donation to install the software application on to the Department's IPAD's. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.
