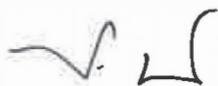

The permit application and various supporting documentation for the above-mentioned applicant were reviewed by staff of the Commission Investigation Division. The investigation performed as part of the application process revealed that:

- The application conforms to the written application requirements for police permits outlined in Los Angeles Municipal Code section 103.02.1.
- The Police Permit Review Panel may issue this permit pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code section 103.102, which regulates the Cafe Entertainment/Show permit.
- No criminal history for the Applicant that should prohibit granting of the permit existed in the California Department of Justice records at the time of investigation.
- No adverse Police Commission permit or disciplinary history was found.
- The Department of Building and Safety has deemed that the business is a permitted use at the location.

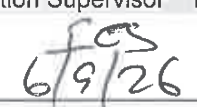

NARRATIVE

SUMMARY:

On April 29, 2026, Detective Ruiz, Serial No. 35238, currently assigned to the Los Angeles Police Department, Commission Investigation Division, Enforcement Section, was assigned this application for further investigation.

AKBAR DELUXE Inc, DBA "AKBAR DELUXE" located at 4356 W. Sunset Blvd, in Northeast Area, applied for a Café Entertainment /Show and Dance Permit.

Permit History:

A computer inquiry through the City of Los Angeles, Office of Finance, LA Tax system revealed a pending permit for AKBAR DELUXE, Inc, DBA: "AKBAR DELUXE" Permit number 000357854400016P519 for CES.

AKBAR DELUXE is an existing bar/dance club with a California State Alcoholic Beverage and Control (ABC) type 48 Liquor License (389323), with operating conditions. This license is for the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on the premises where sold. Food service is not required. Minors are not allowed to enter and remain in the location.

A query on the ZIMAS database revealed a Conditional Use Permit (CUB), ZA-2013-3028-CUB-CUX-PA1 with conditions. The CUB allows for the sale and dispensing of a full line of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption and to permit public patron dancing in conjunction with an existing Lounge/Live entertainment bar. The location is properly zoned for the proposed activities.

INVESTIGATION:

On April 22, 2026, Permit Processing Section (PPS) received an application for a Café Entertainment Show and Dance Police Commission permit.

On April 27, 2026, a notice of application for permit was sent to Northeast Area (Vice), Detective Support and Vice Division (DSVD), Councilman Hugo Soto-Martinez Office, and the neighborhood council. **No opposition was received.**

A review of the State of California Secretary of State Articles of incorporation statement of information of AKBAR DELUXE, Inc, listed David A. LeBarron as the President, Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officer and Director of the company and Albert Loya as the Director and Secretary of the company. Both applicants own 50% of the company and 1,500 each of the shares.

The following applicant backgrounds were reviewed: David A. LeBarron and Albert Loya. A criminal history background check revealed a valid California Driver License, no arrests or convictions in the time prescribed under 103.31 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code and no wants/warrants for both applicants.

On May 7, 2026, at 10:30 AM., Investigator Marney Hansen, Serial No. N5180, and Detective Ruiz conducted a day up-front inspection of "AKBAR DELUXE." We conducted a walk through the location with both owners David LeBarron and Albert Loya

As you enter the venue you can see the lounge with several cocktail tables. The bar is located on the east side of the venue. The dance floor is in a room adjacent to the lounge room on the east side. There will be one to three security guards working on a nightly basis. The company providing the security is Cannon Security. All guards will have guard card and will not carry firearms. There will also be two to three bartenders working. All RBS licenses were valid. An age verification device was provided. There are seven cameras in the interior of the venue and five in the exterior with the capability to store video up to thirty days.

The capacity is 135. The hours of operations will be from 4:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M. Monday thru Sunday. There will only be a DJ playing no live bands will be playing. There is a parking lot located on the southside of the venue with sixteen parking spots and three handicap parking spots. There is also street parking available.

On May 8, 2026, at 10:00 P.M. Officer Sok, Serial No. 42093 and I conducted a nighttime inspection at AKBAR. We were greeted by two security guards who provided valid guard cards and were not armed. We entered the venue and observed two bartenders serving alcoholic drinks to patrons. There were approximately thirty patrons standing and sitting by the cocktail tables. We then entered the dance area where we observed several patrons dancing the night away. We were greeted by the owners who were hosting several patrons. We then stood outside both in the front of the venue and the exterior approximately one hundred feet away. The music emanating was minimal.

The location is in a commercial area and there were no violations as far as public safety issues.

No opposition was received from Northeast Area (Vice), Detective Support and Vice Division (DSVD), Councilman Hugo Soto-Martinez Office, or the Neighborhood Council. There are no zoning issues and no violations were observed during CID's inspections as they pertain to public safety issues.

It is CID's recommendation that the application for a Café Entertainment Show Police Commission permit be granted. AKBAR DELUXE also applied for a Dance Hall Police Commission permit, which will be addressed by the Executive Director after the panel's decision on the entertainment permit.

Recommendation: Grant Permit

CAFE ENTERTAINMENT/SHOW (LAMC 103.102)*

Live entertainment. Includes a disc jockey (DJ) to the extent the DJ performs for/entertains the public. Includes karaoke.

CAFE ENTERTAINMENT/SHOW-ADULT (LAMC 103.102)*

Is the Cafe Entertainment/Show permit at an establishment where the applicant has indicated that entertainment will include a person who performs specified sexual activities or displays specified anatomical parts in the business. See LAMC 103.01. Shall conform to additional requirements.

PICTURE ARCADE (LAMC 103.101)*

Coin-type or electrically controlled still or motion picture machines, image producing devices maintained to display images, or still or motion pictures to five or fewer persons per machine at any one time.

PICTURE ARCADE-ADULT (LAMC 103.101)*

Is the Picture Arcade permit at an establishment where the applicant has indicated the picture arcade has displays which are distinguished or characterized by an emphasis on specified sexual activities or specified anatomical parts. See LAMC 103.01.

MOTION PICTURE SHOW (LAMC 103.109)*

Exhibiting motion pictures to the public in any theater, show house or other place of entertainment.

MOTION PICTURE SHOW-ADULT (LAMC 103.109)*

Is the Motion Picture Show permit at an establishment where the applicant has indicated that a substantial portion of the total presentation time is devoted to the showing of material which is characterized by an emphasis upon the depiction or description of specified sexual activities or specified anatomical parts. See LAMC 103.01.

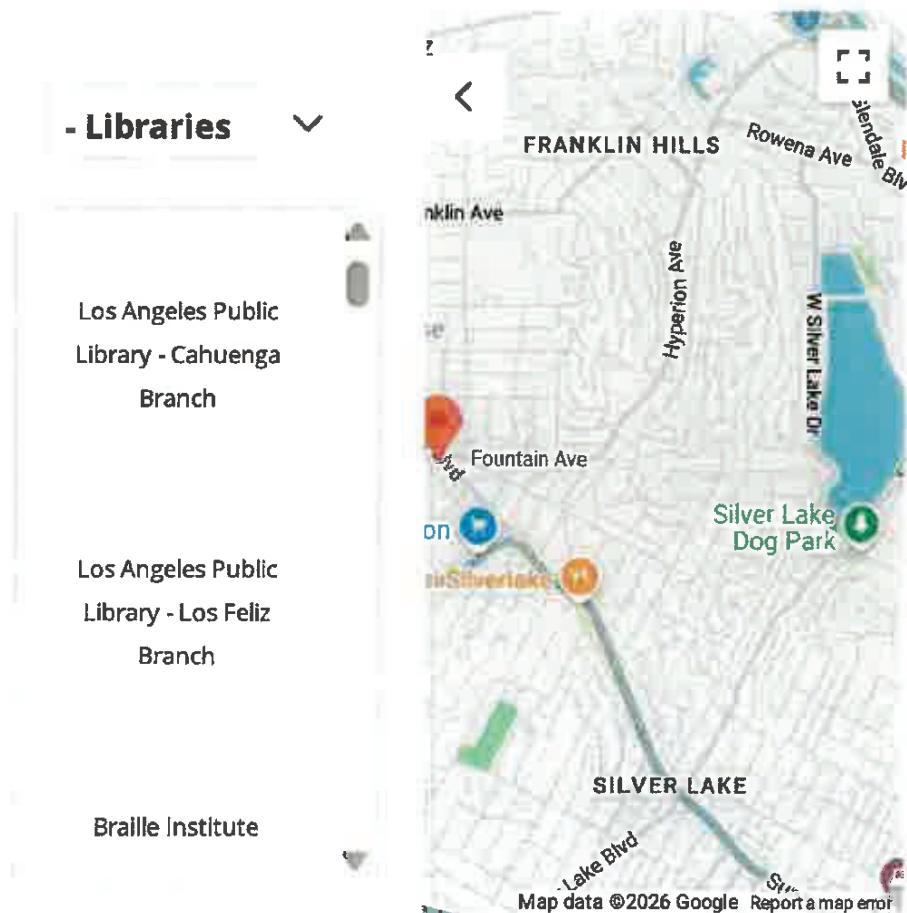
